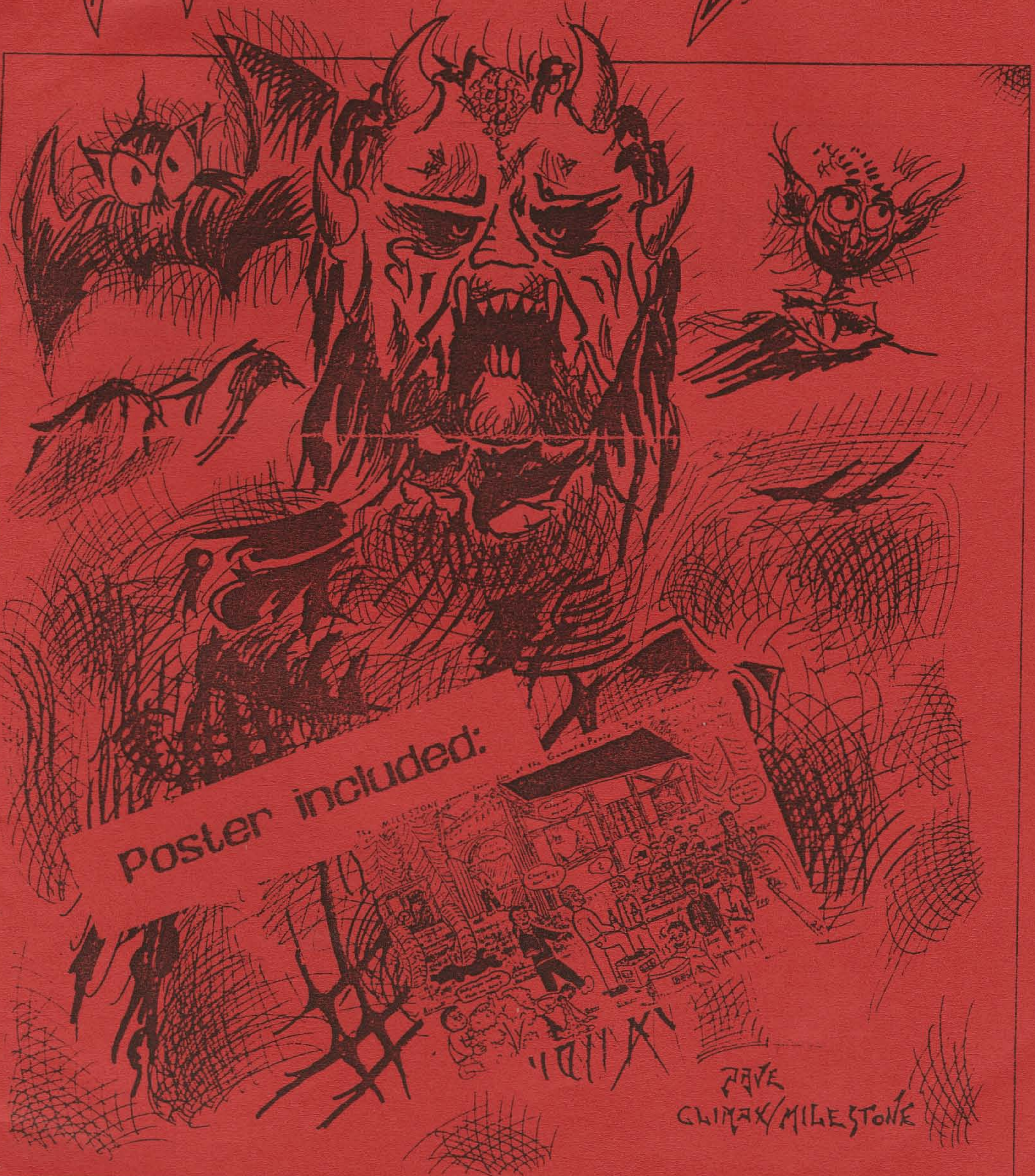

Hook

R: Steven Spielberg / USA 1991

Actors: Robin Williams, Julia Roberts, Dustin Hoffman

Peter Pan was supposed to be the only child who never grew up, but Steven Spielberg has other ideas. In "Hook", Peter "Pan" Banning, played by Robin Williams, is named with children and has become a lawyer. Not satisfied with forgetting his own childhood, he is making that of his offspring a misery by alternatively ignoring and then terrorising them. It takes a journey to his old home in London, a re-union with an ageing Wendy Darling and the children's kidnapping by the wicked Captain Hook to remind him of his heroic past. Spielberg takes a prolonged delight in Banning's/Pan's transformation from level-headed corporate executive to the swashbuckling young hero. Captain Hook (Dustin Hoffman) loves to hate. Once Peter Banning pursues Hook to find his children in Neverland, the director is free to give full rein to his imagination. But, as Pan takes to the air, the film goes into a tail-spin and the pace begins to flag. There is far more here for kids than for adults - as it should be perhaps, but disappointing all the time.

Demo Reviews

Moahltiedd! On the following pages you'll find the Demoreviews... it's the first time I (Nyarlathotep) am doing reviews like this, so sometimes they might be a bit strange... I reviewed the demos under different point of views, like coding (most important...), the graphics, design (colours, construction, not regarding the quality of the gfx). I didn't test the music itself, but how it fits to the part (as everyone has a different music-taste and as it's very hard to find a music that suits -perfectly- to a part...). First I wanted to give no grades but it was a bit hard to calculate everthing in percent, so that I turned over to grades... (from 1 to 6; 1 is the best, 6 the worst (german schoolmarks)). I also checked the covering to the demo-name, sort of demo (menu, continuesly, part after part) and the length of the texts ('n the contests). I didn't take these into consideration when giving the marks except for "continuesly demo", as it's harder to code them...

Global Puke by Extend

Part after Part-Demo; no covering to the name. This is the first "real" demo by Extend, featuring many skulls, short texts, many graphics by Electric (a picture by him is in front of every part) and a coool line-dot-scroll with 1536 dots. Regrettable the design wasn't the best. Intro: a multifunctional Intro; cool idea to show the memberspics'n dates like a pass-port. Part 1: sideborder DYCP (no scroll!), up is border contact part. Part 2: very cool, "Bobscroll" (kinda animated scroll) used a good sprutler which is unfortunately a bit too slow. Part 3: featuring a pseudo FLI-Scroll, cool skulls, too much "EXT" or "Extend". 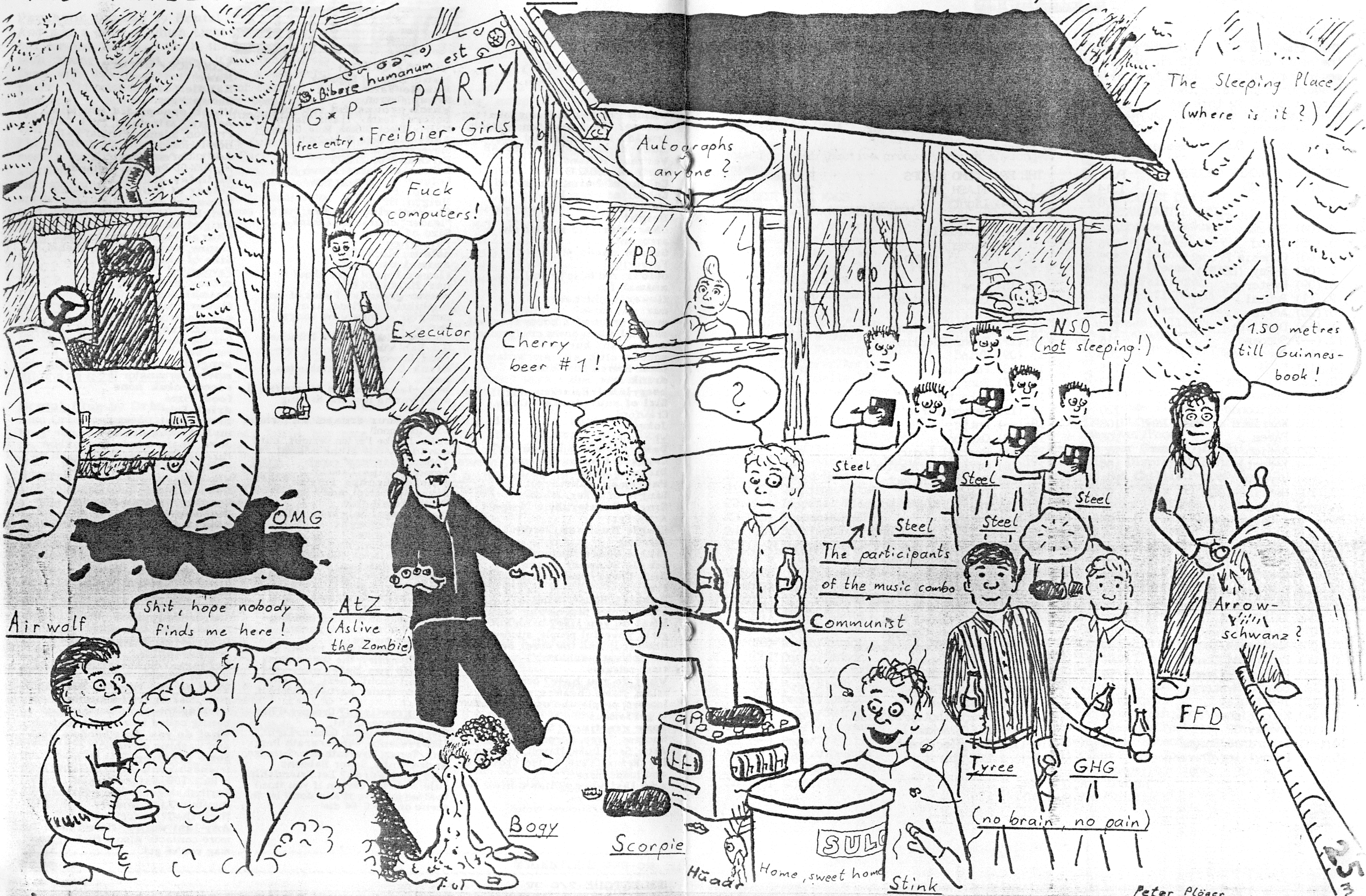
